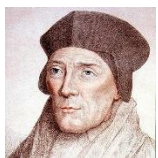

There will be plastic knives, forks, spoons, paper plates, plastic bowls and serviettes but if you would prefer to bring your own utensils please feel free to do so. The main celebrant will be the Apostolic Nuncio Archbishop Peter Wells and concelebrants Msgr. Roman Walczak together with Father Bogdan. Following Mass, confessions will be heard for anyone requiring this sacrament. The church will remain open for adoration for as long as is necessary on Holy Thursday. Blessing of the food that will be consumed on Easter Sunday is an Eastern European tradition which makes the Easter celebrations that much more respectful. If you would like to partake in this tradition please bring your food with you for this special blessing by Father Bogdan.
