Notice for preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism has to be done at least one month before the date of Baptism.

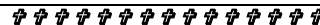

## PRAYER FOR THE EXTRAORDINARY JUBILEE OF MERCY



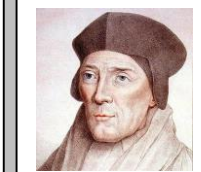
Lord Jesus Christ,
