



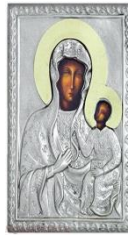

2<sup>nd</sup> Altar – under the trees near the braai area, prepared by the Catechism classes – Stanley King to co-ordinate.

4<sup>th</sup> Altar – in the garden, prepared by CWL – Delene Holt to co-ordinate.
