**TWENTY FIFTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME YEAR B,  
19 SEPTEMBER 2021**

**INTRODUCTION TO THE MASS**

The world we live in, despite its beauty and grandeur, often appears to be a frightening place. War, violence, injustice, hunger, and oppression cast a long shadow over so much of the globe. Today, we call to mind that much of that shadow is due to the fact that man tries to be the God of his own living. He forgets his divine origin and destiny. He acts solely out

of his own wisdom and forgets the wisdom of God, made known to us in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

### **HEADINGS FOR THE READINGS**

First Reading (Wis. 2:12, 17-20). Virtuous people often evoke a malicious response in the ungodly, who then set out to destroy them.

Second Reading (James 3:16-4:3). James contrasts the wisdom that comes from God with that which has its source in man alone. The former brings peace and harmony; the latter gives rise to conflict and injustice.

The Gospel (Mk. 9:30-37). Jesus tells his disciples that he will suffer and die and be raised from the dead. They do not understand him.

### **PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL**

PRIEST: St Augustine once said: 'You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts will never rest until they rest in you'. Let us pray now for peace and harmony in our own lives and in the lives of all people.

5. Help us, Lord, not to waste time with evil intentions or deeds. Give us the courage to oppose evil in our own lives and in social life. Lord, hear us.
6. Help us, Lord, to forgive others who have offended us. Give us the grace of tolerance, and the willingness to co-operate with others in the cause of good. Lord, hear us.

PRIEST: Father, be present to us in our daily lives. Grant that our work and living may make the world a better place to live in. Help us in our battle against evil in all its forms. This we ask through Christ our Lord. Amen.

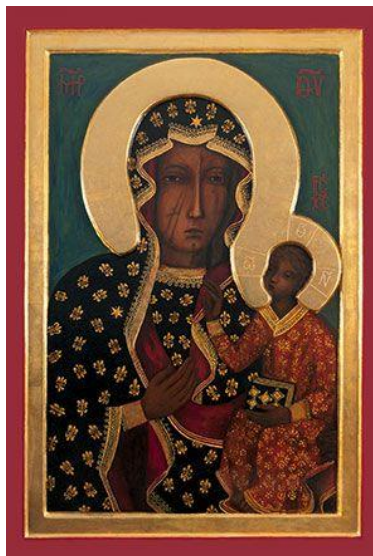
