

INTEREST FACTS ON PENTECOST ~ COMPLIMENTS OF THE SOUTHERN CROSS

- Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room.
- A "strong, driving" wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came
 to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages so that they could
 understand each other.



- The main event of Pentecost takes place in <u>Acts 2:13</u>, though the events immediately following (Peter's homily, the baptism of thousands) continue to verse 41.
- Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Church because Peter, the first pope, preaches for the first time and
 converts thousands of new believers. The apostles and believers, for the first time, were united by a common
 language, and a common zeal and purpose to go and preach the Gospel.
- Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension into heaven. Because Easter is a moveable feast without a fixed date, and Pentecost depends on the timing of Easter, Pentecost can fall anywhere between May 10 and June 13.
- The name of the day itself is derived from the Greek word *pentecoste*, meaning 50th.
- Priests wear red vestments on Pentecost, symbolic of the burning fire of God's love and the tongues of fire that
 descended on the apostles.

WISDOM, UNDERSTANDING, COUNSEL, FORTITUDE, KNOWLEDGE, PIETY, AND FEAR OF THE LORD. Sunday 28 May 2023 – Pentecost is the birthday of the Catholic Church. The youth committee invites young and old to make a kite and bring it along to the 09:30 Mass this Sunday. We will be serving tea, coffee and complimentary cake while we watch the kites being launched in the park. Prizes for those who participate – e.g. the largest kite, smallest kite, most original kite, most colourful kite etc.
