THIRTY FIRST SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME YEAR B 31 OCTOBER 2021

INTRODUCTION TO THE MASS

'They'll know we are Christians by our love' the song says. Jesus in today's Gospel shows that the one great law of life for his followers is to love - to love God and neighbour. It is not to be a half-hearted love, but one that comes from the whole person. That is why we

come together to celebrate this Mass, not just from an obligation but because we want to give ourselves to God and to each other in this celebration.

HEADINGS FOR READINGS

First reading (Deut. 6: 2-6). The people of Israel, having been shown the blessings of fertility in the land given to them by the Lord God, are called on to remember the giver. But remember with a love that is more than just duty but is sincerely from heart and soul. Second reading (Heb; 7:23-28). Jesus Christ became our high priest, making intercession for us, when he offered himself on the cross. But he continues that priestly work at the right hand of his Father.

In the Gospel (Mk. 12:28-34) Jesus brings together all the commandments into one, the commandment to love.

PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL

Jesus Christ is living for ever to intercede for all who come to God through him. Let us approach with confidence to God, our Father, to pray for our needs.

Response: Lord, hear our prayer.

- 1. That all Christians may be known by their love for God and for all their fellowmen, so that Christ's own love may be preached in their lives; let us pray to the Lord.
- 2. That the material prosperity of our world may not lead us to forget the God who has given us every blessing; let us pray to the Lord.
- 3. That we may open our hearts to all the members of our community, putting aside all hatred and thoughts of revenge, forgiving all who may have offended us; let us pray to the Lord.
- 4. For faithfulness all the days of our lives in carrying out the commandments of Christ and his Church; let us pray to the Lord.
- 5. As we have gathered to meet Christ in his Word and in his Sacrament we pray that we may meet him in the faces of those who come to us in need; let us pray to the Lord.
- 6. The Eucharist is the Body given for us, the Blood poured out for us. We pray that we may become the Eucharist to others by giving ourselves with a love that is sincere; let us pray to the Lord.

Lord God, you are our help and refuge, you are worthy of all praise. We thank you for your love shown to us in so many blessings. Be for us always our strength and joy. We make our prayer through Christ our Lord.

COMMUNION REFLECTION

Lord, we thank you for calling us together to share this Eucharistic meal. May we fully understand that our union with Christ in the Eucharist must be expressed in the truth of our lives - in our actions, in our behaviour, in our treatment of others. Let this Eucharist be for each of us a call to greater effort, so that we may be true followers of Jesus; generous in

our deeds, concerned, caring and respectful of the dignity of all persons. Help us realise that in this Eucharist we receive your Body only to build up the body of mankind.



My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
